SCHOLARSHIP

Fisheries programs across the University of Alaska system collaborate to provide a workforce for federal and state organizations, public and private non-profit salmon and shellfish hatcheries, and strive to help maintain the health of Alaska's waters and aquatic resources. In support of this mission, faculty from fisheries programs across UA make scholarship funding available to students entering or enrolled in a fisheries or fisheries-related program. The number of awards given and amounts vary, but typically range from \$500 to \$2,000. To be eligible, students must apply and be admitted to a fisheries or fisheries-related program through the University of Alaska.

To apply for a Fisheries Scholarship, applicants must submit a one-page typed essay as a PDF to include the following:

- Why you have chosen to enroll in a fisheries or fisheries related program
- Your educational and career goals
- How this scholarship can help overcome any barriers or challenges in reaching academic goals
- Additional information the scholarship selection committee may consider when evaluating candidacy (optional)

For priority consideration, the submission deadline is August 15 for fall semester and December 1 for spring semester.
